C1 Motorhome Medicals

A legal requirement for drivers of motorhomes

Why do motorhome drivers require a C1 medical?

In the UK, it is a legal requirement for motorhome drivers to be assessed as to whether they are medically fit to drive?

Drivers that learnt to drive before 1997 have the C1 category as “grandfather rights” on their car driving licence. When you turn 70, you must have a medical & then every 3 years after.

Every new motorhome driver (from 1997 onwards) requires a medical prior to applying for a provisional licence. Any current motorhome driver must undergo a medical every 5 years from age 45 up to 65, then annually from 65.

Who will carry out your C1 medical?

The medical is carried out by a GMC registered doctor.

What do you need to bring with you?

- ▶ D4 medical examination report/form.
- ▶ Photographic ID with the correct corresponding address.
- ▶ If you wear glasses/contact lenses for driving then please bring them with you.
- ▶ If you have a copy of your most recent prescription (glasses/contacts) then please bring.
- ▶ A record of your GP's name and address.
